2019 “DESCENTE” SAUVIGNON BLANC

Appearance: Pale green /straw.

Aroma: Attractive aromas of lemongrass, crushed nettles and guava with a little grapefruit fruit kicking in behind too. Maybe just a touch of flintiness in the mix as well. Aromatic and very varietal.

Palate: The palate is crisp, fresh and zingy – the acid working beautifully with the fruit providing both structure and length.

Summary: The Adelaide Hills is one of Australia’s leading regions for Sauvignon Blanc production. Our Lenswood vineyard continues to produce lovely examples. Try this with chicken satays or with salt and pepper squid. Drink now and the next 2-3 years.
